* DO YOU KNOW FOR CERTAIN THAT YOUR PILL WAS ORIGINALLY PRESCRIBED TO SOMEONE BY A DOCTOR?

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TAKE A SMALLER AMOUNT INITIALLY THAN YOU THINK YOU WANT. AVOID USE IN HIGHER-RISK SITUATIONS, SUCH AS WHILE DRIVING, OR WITH PEOPLE YOU DON'T TRUST. SET PERSONAL BOUNDARIES ABOUT YOUR USE TO AVOID EXCESSIVE OR COMPULSIVE RE-DOSING.
*DO YOU PLAN TO USE BENZOS IN COMBINATION WITH OTHER DRUGS?



ABOVE ALL, AVOID COMBINING BENZOS WITH ALCOHOL, GHB OR OPIOIDS; THESE COMBINATIONS ARE EXTRA-RISKY AND CAN BE FATAL.
